Safety on the Streets

Motor Vehicles: Parking

- No Motor Vehicle’s(which by definition includes “Motor Cycles”) shall be parked anywhere on the property except in drive ways and or garages or any other area the association may deem as a designated parking area, under no circumstances shall any motor vehicle be allowed to park on the street
- Vehicles in violation of this “No Street Parking” provision are subject to all sanctions including towing
- No Vehicles which are primarily used for commercial purposes, other than service vehicles, temporarily present on business, nor any trailers, may be parked on the association property.
- Trucks, Boats, Trailers, Semi-Trailers, House Trailers, Campers, Travel Trailers, Mobile Homes, Motor Homes, Recreational Vehicles, and the like, and any Vehicles not in operable condition or validly licensed, may be kept on the property including Golf Carts, for the purpose of the forgoing sentence, the term “Kept” shall mean present for either a period of Six (6) , consecutive hours or overnight, which ever is less
