Speeding

Residents near the entry gate have noticed that some drivers exiting from within the community tend to reach excessive speeds by the time they reach the gate area. These drivers need to understand that there are many residents within close proximity of the gate with small children. Now that the area outside the gates has been made safer by relocating school bus traffic, we need to focus on keeping the areas inside and near the gate safer for residents living nearby. If the problem persists, the board may be forced to ask the sheriff's department to come into the community and issue speeding tickets.

Community Park Garbage Removal

Residents who might be bringing trash from home to deposit in the park trash receptacles because they missed the regular trash removal day or they want to dispose of the trash before going away or for any other reason at all, should realize that Lee county does not pick up the trash there. We are solely responsible for removing trash that accumulates. Trash receptacles were initially placed there by the community to control litter in the park; if people bring trash from elsewhere, then those receptacles will quickly be prone to overflow and that will defeat their very purpose. The board is asking for volunteer/s from the community to remove it on a regular basis. Also needed are volunteers for the Architectural Review Committee due to a recent vacancy.
